





1/2 cup of maple syrup
1/3 cup of chopped
crystallized ginger
1/2 cup of apricot preserves
2 tablespoons butter
1/3 teaspoon salt

CANDIED-GINGER SWEET POTATOES RECIPE BY SECRETARY ROSS STRETTON

OK, if you are one that does not care for the taste of sweet potatoes, you may change your mind after tasting this recipe.

RECIPE INSTRUCTIONS:

Preparation Time 20 minutes Bake 40 minutes Makes 10 servings

Place the sweet potatoes in a 15in X 10in X 1in baking pan. Drizzle with oil and toss to coat. Bake uncovered at 400 degrees fah. for 30 minutes, stirring twice.

In a microwave-safe bowl, combine the remaining ingredients. Cover and microwave on high for 1-2 minutes or until heated through. Pour over sweet potatoes, toss to coat. Bake 10-15 minutes longer or until tender.

This type of collaboration will elevate Spearhead's profile and bring the leather and kink community into more mainstream visibility, ensuring our community grows both in size and respect.
- 4. Increased Involvement in the Kink/Leather Community Spearhead's influence should extend beyond our club's borders. We should be showing up at other kink and leather related events and venues, representing who we are. By taking part in events across the community, we strengthen our identity and become a more visible and active organization. It's time for Spearhead to be seen and respected beyond just our own gatherings.
- 5. Collaboration with Other Clubs Our club can only grow by learning from and working with others. I'm committed to initiating outreach to collaborate with other clubs, like PALS, to share ideas, resources, and event opportunities. These partnerships will create mutual benefits, allowing us to grow stronger through cooperation and shared experiences.

CANDIDATE FOR TREASURER: CONNOR MACLEOD

I, Connor A. MacLeod, announce and confirm my campaign for Treasurer on the Board of Directors for Spearhead. I bring to the membership my varied background and experience that I believe will prove to benefit the role as Treasurer and to Spearhead and its members that make and have made Spearhead what we know it as today.

From the time I became a member of Spearhead in 2023 until today, it has been an honour to contribute to Spearhead as a standing member of our Constitution Committee, as the Nominations and Elections Co-Chair and



volunteering time and/or resources at the various events we run to help fellow aligned organisations. While these roles and acts are important for Spearhead, our members, and our community; I believe that for real and positive change to happen, we must ensure our organisational stability and fiscal security.

My priorities as your Treasurer are:

Ensuring Fiscal Compliance and Stability with full accountability to the membership. This includes that:

- Use of Spearhead funds is for the benefit of all Spearhead members.
- Our finances are available on a rolling basis to the membership, exceeding the minimum requirements under Ontario Not-for-Profit Laws and our current standards.
- We research and deploy affordable, accessible and new technologies to decrease our expenses, increase accountability and accessibility of the organisation to members and increase member enlistment and renewals.
- We solicit the memberships' approval for any expense the organisation wishes to incur for its advancement that is not approved in our budget(s).

Outside of the role as treasurer, I believe that my contribution and role on the board can be used for benevolent purposes. To name a few:

- Propose hybrid membership and board meetings that allow members who cannot
 physically attend a meeting to actively participate. I would seek guidance from The
 Imperial Court of Toronto and fellow organisations that employ a mixed live-and-virtual
 meeting method.
- Increase overall accessibility by implementing guidelines for Spearhead when considering venues, products and services.
- Increase our marketability to younger queer and allied community members.
- Ensure meeting decorum and proper records keeping.

There are many ways Spearhead can be the collective representation and organisation for all leather and denim people where we live and serve. It takes those with determination and a can-do attitude to make that happen. For the members and for all, it is our time to choose change, to choose better, and it will be a great honour to be elected as your Treasurer to allow Spearhead to grow and become the preeminent club of its kind in our region.

CANDIDATE FOR MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR: KRIS JOSEPH

Dear brothers, sisters, and all those in between:

When I joined Spearhead, I was surprised to learn that the organization doesn't share its members list internally, even though the application form asks each person to provide consent to have their contact information shared. Work on this front is one of my commitments to the membership as part of this role. At two 2023 OGMs I requested that consenting members have selected contact information shared with their colleagues. I believe it is critical for members of our social club to be able to contact other consenting members for the purpose



of socializing. I also believe this practice requires a set of acceptable use guidelines that govern the ways in which contact information is used, with abuse of the guidelines serving as cause for censure.

Creating a welcoming club means delivering a warm and friendly experience for new applicants. The current application process can be clarified, including an online application form and easy means of submitting payments. Moreover, we can define standards of service (acceptable processing times) for handling new applications, and report to the Board on our adherence to those standards. I will commit to this work on behalf of the club. I am an academic librarian by trade, and currently serve as director of a department that manages critical digital infrastructure for Canada's third-largest university. I have been involved in the local kink and BDSM community since early 2020 and have cohosted both the LEDGE leather dinners and the Black Eagle's GLUE event each month since early 2023.

My related Board experience includes 2 three-year terms as a councillor for Canadian Actors' Equity Association, where I led a national, multi-year committee that evaluated and recommended changes to independent theatre production contracts from 2010-2012. For Spearhead, I have served on the Constitution Committee, and currently serve alongside Connor MacLeod as Nominations Chair. In this role, we have carefully and transparently managed this year's nominations, with regular updates to membership. This is the spirit of openness and transparency we hope to foster more widely in the affiliation. In addition to the points above, I commit to the following as your future membership director:

- 1. Openness, transparency, and accountability for the affairs of the Board and its committees. I believe the Board needs to be "open by default" to align with the expectations of the current leather and kink community.
- 2. Ongoing and active member recruitment through liaisons with other local groups.
- 3. Clarity about and promotion of value-added member benefits such as gear discounts and member-only pricing for events.
- 4. Advocacy for better access to Open General Meetings for members who cannot attend in person, including phone and online options for remote participation. Our members in Gatineau, Winnipeg, Kitchener, Halifax, etc should not be barred from participating in discussions and votes due to their inability to attend OGMs in person in downtown Toronto.
- 5. Advocacy for Spearhead-sponsored educational workshops, with member discounts, that cover topics like leather care, bootblacking, consent practices, Sir/boy dynamics, and BDSM skills.

I would be proud to serve as your Membership Director and want to express gratitude for the work Joe Poirier has been doing in the role. I hope you'll consider casting a ballot in my favour.






"Pivotal Art Movements of Kensington Market: CEAC and ChromaZone"

Thursday, October 10, 2024, 6:30pm Paul Cadario Conference Centre University College, 15 King's College Circle







NATIONAL DAY FOR TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION

#OrangeShirtDay



Each year, September 30 marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family and community intergenerational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations. All Canadians are encouraged to wear orange to honour the thousands of Survivors of residential schools.

The inspiration for Orange Shirt Day came from residential school survivor Phyllis Jack Webstad, who recounted her first day of residential schooling at six years old, when she was stripped of her clothes, including the new orange shirt her grandmother bought her, which was never returned. 




