Cover Art

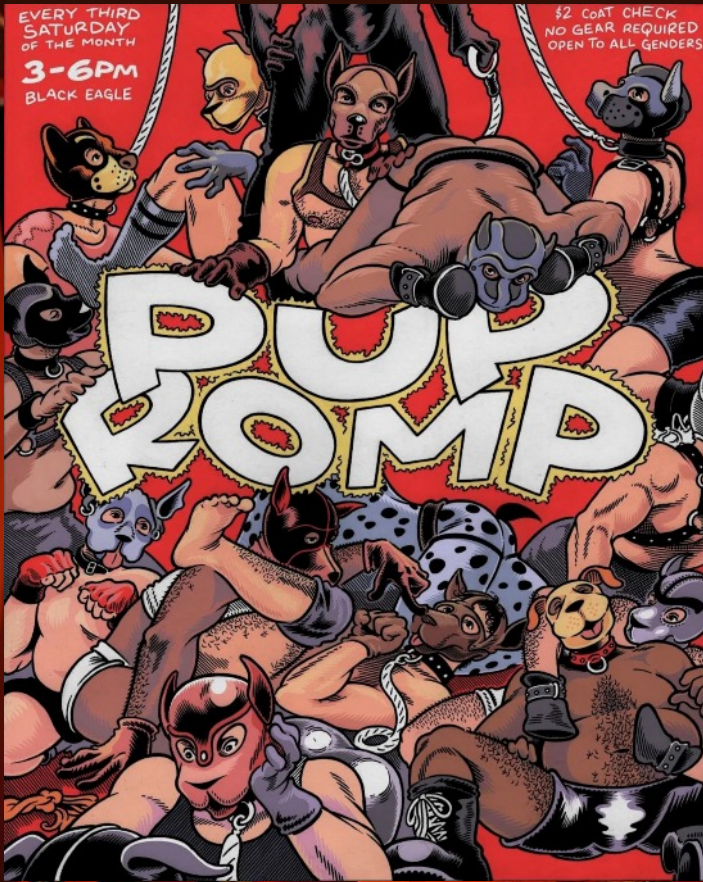
This month we featured Matt from Ottawa. He works at our sponsor advertiser, Stroked Ego. He is also an organizer for BLUF Ottawa.

WHAT DOES SPEARHEAD MEAN TO YOU?

For many of us, Spearhead Leather Denim Social Club is more than a logo on a vest, a patch on a jacket, or a name on a membership card. It is a community. It is a history. It is a responsibility. Most importantly, it is a reflection of the people who choose to be part of it.

But when was the last time you stopped and asked yourself a simple question:

What does Spearhead mean to you?

For some members, the answer may begin with friendship. Spearhead has brought together people from different backgrounds, experiences, and walks of life. Through meetings, socials, fundraising events, and community gatherings, many of us have formed bonds that extend far beyond club functions. Some members have found lifelong friends. Others have found mentors, chosen family, or a sense of belonging that was missing elsewhere.

For others, Spearhead may represent service.

Since its founding, the club has raised thousands of dollars for charitable causes and community organizations. Every raffle ticket sold, every event organized, every hour volunteered contributes to something larger than ourselves. Fundraising is not simply about collecting money; it is about demonstrating that our community cares and that we are willing to invest our time and energy in helping others.

When you volunteer for a Spearhead event, what motivates you? Is it the cause? Is it the camaraderie? Is it the satisfaction of knowing you helped create something meaningful? Perhaps it is all of the above.

Then there is advocacy.

The leather and denim communities have always been built upon principles of visibility, acceptance, education, and mutual respect. Spearhead has often stood as a voice for these values. Whether marching in Pride, supporting LGBTQ+ initiatives, educating newcomers, or preserving traditions, the club has played a role in ensuring our communities remain visible and vibrant.

What role do you believe Spearhead should play in advocacy today? Has that role changed over the years? Should it evolve further?

And, of course, there is the leather and denim itself.

Leather and denim are more than clothing. They represent traditions, culture, identity, and history. For some, they symbolize freedom and self-expression. For others, they represent discipline, respect, brotherhood, and shared values. The symbols we wear connect us to generations of community members who came before us and who worked to create spaces where we could gather openly and proudly.

Do we still understand the significance of those traditions? Are we passing them on to newer members? Are we preserving the stories that helped shape our community?

Looking back, many longtime members remember a different Spearhead. Some remember larger events. Others remember different leadership styles, traditions, or priorities. Every era of the club has brought successes, challenges, and lessons.

The question is not whether the Spearhead of today is identical to the Spearhead of yesterday. No organization remains unchanged forever.

The real question is:

What parts of our history should we preserve, and what parts should we build upon?

Every member will have a different answer.

Some will value brotherhood above all else.

Some will focus on fundraising and charitable work.

Some will champion advocacy and visibility.

Some will be passionate about preserving leather and denim traditions.

Others may simply appreciate having a place where they feel welcomed and accepted.

None of these answers are wrong.



In fact, it is the combination of all these perspectives that has allowed Spearhead to endure.

As we look toward the future, perhaps the most important thing we can do is reflect on what this club means to each of us personally. Organizations are not defined by constitutions, bylaws, patches, or titles alone. They are defined by the people who participate in them and the values they choose to uphold.

So, as you read this issue, consider taking a moment to answer the question for yourself:

What does Spearhead mean to you?

And perhaps even more importantly:

What do you want Spearhead to mean for the next generation of members who will one day wear the patch, carry the banner, and continue the legacy?

The future of Spearhead is not written by any one officer, board member, or committee.

It is written by all of us.

One event.

One volunteer.

One act of brotherhood.

One member at a time.

VOICES FROM THE PAST

I have come out of the closet to explain how "PHALIA" came to be. Well, my friends, let me tell you, it was born in 1970 in the backyard of what was then called "WINCHESTER CATHEDRAL" - in Bruce Anderson's home in Cabbage-Town (in 1970 we had limited places that we could go without police harassment etc). We congregated for the first time - as I recall there were 23 of us - not all Torontonians, but some members of "CYCLE MC NY" and from the then newly formed "NINE PLUS" Club in New York.

We had a wonderful time, drinking gallons of beer (what has changed?). That night I went home and typed on my old manual Olivetti what was the first edition of "PHALIA".

How I came about the name is another story which we will deal with here in the late sixties and early seventies, any mention of what might be called 'porn' was immediately seized on by the Vice Squad, the Legion of Decency (what ever happened to them?) and of course the all powerful 'Daughters of the British Empire' so trying to skirt around all these faction, I seized on the name "PHALIA" - you could not use 'PHALLUS' or

any other connotation that smelt of 'porn' because it was a NO-NO! I wanted a name that would stick with the organization, and be symbolic of it - so I created the word "PHALIA" which of course, is a combination of 'Phallus' and using good journalistic sense, thought that if we related to what might be construed as a disaster viz: "FAILURE" figured, in my twisted frame of mind, that the minute you put yourself 'down' then the program is bound to succeed.

So, we published our first issue of PHALIA, a 2 page hand-out printed on various photocopiers that we had access to. It was read in the "PARKSIDE" the very next Saturday!

My explanation to the Vice-Squad, who happened to call us quite frequently, in those days, was that if they could find the word in Chambers Dictionary, which was the BIBLE of the English language, they could sue us! They never found it - because it doesn't exist - and we had no further problem from any of them.

Obviously, it has grown since then and I am proud of the fact that it is now internationally recognized as the official newsletter of SPEARHEAD.

In my next broadcast I will share with you some of the 'horror stories' of the early publications. *****Enjoy!

GRILLED CORN RIBS

Ingredients:

- 4 Ears Fresh Corn Cobs
- ½ Cup Unsalted Butter, melted
- 2 tsp. Kosher Salt
- 1 tsp. Smoked Paprika
- 1 tsp. Black Pepper
- ½ tsp. Cumin
- (Optional) Fresh Cilantro

Preheat grill to high (450°F to 500°F). Cut corn ears in half crosswise using a sharp knife. Trim about 1 inch from pointed ends; discard trimmed ends. Working with 1 half at a time, turn each piece of corn on its flattest, widest cut end, and carefully cut in half lengthwise. Turn corn halves cut sides down; cut in half lengthwise again. Repeat with remaining corn. Place corn ribs in an even layer on a large, rimmed baking sheet; set aside.

Stir together melted butter, salt, paprika, pepper, and cumin in a small bowl; brush evenly over corn. Place on oiled grates; grill, uncovered, turning often, until corn is charred and tender, 6 to 8 minutes. Squeeze lime wedges over corn ribs; sprinkle with cilantro, if desired.

SUMMER FLOUNDER A L'ORANGE

Ingredients:

- 1 ½ Flounder Fillets, cut into serving pieces
- 2 Tbs. Fresh Orange Juice
- 1 Tba. Grated Orange Rind
- 2 Tbs. Vegetable Oil
- 1 tsp. Nutmeg
- 1 tsp. Salt
- 1 tsp. Pepper

1. Combine orange juice, vegetable oil, salt, grated orange rind and pepper.
2. Place fish in a greased shallow pan. Pour sauce over fish. Sprinkle with nutmeg.
3. Bake in 350 degree oven for 20-30 minutes. Do not over bake. Serves 4.
